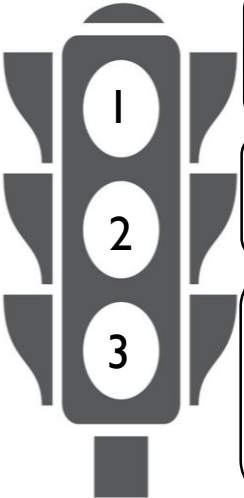

Yr10-5. Introduction to Language including Speaking and Listening presentations. Crafting stories.

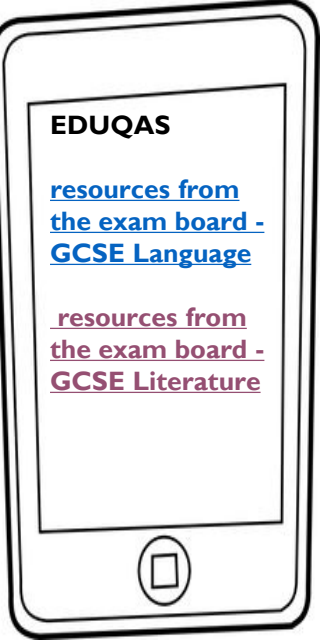


1 Encourage viewings (live or on screen) of all key texts
