TERMS OF REFERENCE

Governors with Chair responsibilities with the Head Teacher would have a more strategic and co-ordinating role and would add to the effectiveness of the work of the Governing Body. Full meetings of the Governing Body, with their long agendas, do not allow sufficient time for this activity.

Members: Chair of Governors, Vice-Chair of Governors, Chairs of major 'working' Committees and Head Teacher

Quorum: Minimum of 2 Governors to be present

Delegated powers:

The Group has **NO** delegated powers. Its purpose is to better inform the deliberations of the Governing Body and its various Committees

Terms of reference:

1. To exercise oversight of the strategic planning and development work of the Governing Body and to advise the Governing Body and Committees accordingly.
2. To have oversight of and to co-ordinate the contributions of the Governing Body's Committees to the formulation of the SEF and the School Improvement Plan
3. To consider any recommendations from Committees, Governors or the Head Teacher with regard to the working of the Governing Body.
4. To keep under review the Governing Body's Code of Conduct.
5. To be available at short notice as source of support and advice to the Head Teacher.
