Exam information – to be confirmed

- The intention is for formal exams go ahead in 2022, but with some adaptations aimed at making them fairer to pupils who have missed out on parts of their education.
- The Department for Education and Ofqual have a completed a consultation proposing a package of measures to help mitigate the impact of disruption to students' education. They have sought views on proposals on the following areas:
- choice of topics in GCSE English Literature, History and choice of content in GCSE Geography
- changes to the requirements for the delivery of practical activities in Science subjects, and assessment in Art and Design
- the provision of advance information on the focus of the content of exams, in the majority of subjects at GCSE
- the provision of support materials in GCSE Mathematics, Physics and Combined Science exams
- Once the outcome of this consultation has been published we will communicate that information.





Exam information – firm decisions

 GCSE English Language – we no longer need to submit an audio-visual recording of students undertaking their spoken language assessments.

 GCSE Geography - the exam boards will not ask questions in written examinations about fieldwork.

• GCSE Spanish - return to formal speaking tests in 2022

What is it?



Start now and use often

Just like training for a marathon, you need to start early and train little and often.

Revision Strategy of the Week

- Each week for the next ten weeks we will give your child a new revision strategy every Monday in tutorial time
- They should try to use this strategy in at least one of their subjects that week - this will arm them with a number of approaches
- They will find some more useful than others everyone learns differently
- The essential thing is finding which is most EFFECTIVE for them (not just the one that they like!)







In addition to class teacher subject support and form teacher pastoral support in school, there are a variety of opportunities on offer -

- Tutoring opportunities via Tutor the Nation and the National Tutoring programme
- Academic mentoring with the Year team
- The 'Bright Leaders' course a provision which supports the development of key leadership skills
- Opportunities to form the very first student leadership group who have an active voice in the development of Thornleigh
- All students will be offered a careers appointment with our dedicated careers advisor



Sixth form application process



- Your child will be receiving support with this on a weekly basis during their form tutorial sessions. Sixth form teachers will be leading on this, talking your child through the application process.
- Further information will be given to your child about post 16 options and opportunities in Year Group assemblies.
- Taster sessions will also be delivered to give your child an insight into some KS5 subjects they have not had access to at KS4 e.g. Economics, Psychology, Criminology, Sociology and Performing Arts.
- The deadline for the application will be January 30th 2022. This will allow students time to have received some progress data from their PPEs to allow them to make the most informed decision.
