WHAT'S YOUR JOB?

In a typical day, I will set up for operations, including preparing the operating theatre and drugs for administration. I will prepare the animals (cats, dogs and small animals) for theatre. I support the pets with their welfare needs before, during and after procedures, supporting them while in recovery. Providing consultations to pet owners and of course there is cleaning to be done, everyone in the practice gets stuck in.

WHAT IS THE MOST EXCITING PROJECT YOU HAVE WORKED ON?

I would say the most exciting procedure I was able to scrub in for is a TECA (total ear canal ablation). This is an operation to remove the ear canal. I held the ear canal up while the veterinary surgeon cut around it. This is a particularly tricky operation as there are important facial nerves in close proximity to the ear canal.

WHAT IS YOUR PROUDEST MOMENT WITH YOUR COMPANY?

I've had many! I'm getting catheters in first time 9 times out of 10 occasions. I'm also smashing my college targets. Taking part in theatre procedures and learning from them makes me proud.
